MR LAST ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise what percentage of crime in Townsville was committed by juveniles in the current year and the previous two years?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Police Service has advised that juveniles accounted for 17 percent of all crime each year in 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18.

(Note that from 12 February 2018 juvenile offenders are defined as being between 10 and 17 years (inclusive). For consistency, the new age range has been used to identify juveniles for each time period.)
